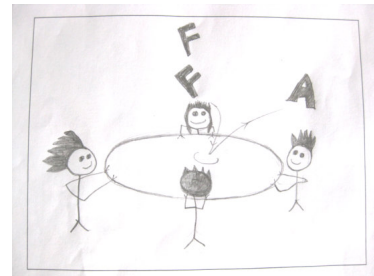

Christmas Fayre (run by school, but F&F volunteers too) - ~£500.00
Donated Hi-Viz tabards – value of ~£450.00
Donated Glitter Ball – value of ~£20.00
Tea Towels (still some left, but currently at loss of £20.00)
UK PTA membership (including insurance) £25.00 (not renewed this year)

GRAND TOTAL - ALMOST £1,700

So far the funds raised by F&F have contributed towards:

- 105 Hi-viz tabards
- Glitter Ball
- Spot light
- Disco lights
- Charlotte's Web Theatre visit for whole school

Future ideas for projects that F&F funds might contribute towards include:

- “Start-up funding” for Tuck-Shop to be run by Year 6 pupils (perhaps next school year)
- Painting of floor-games on the playground / walls
- Outdoor toys for break times
