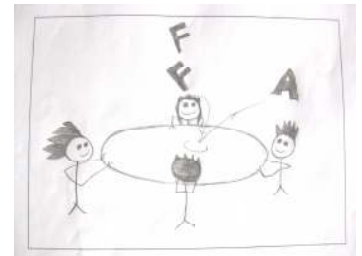




# Airmyn Park Primary School Friends & Family Association NEWSLETTER – September 2014
